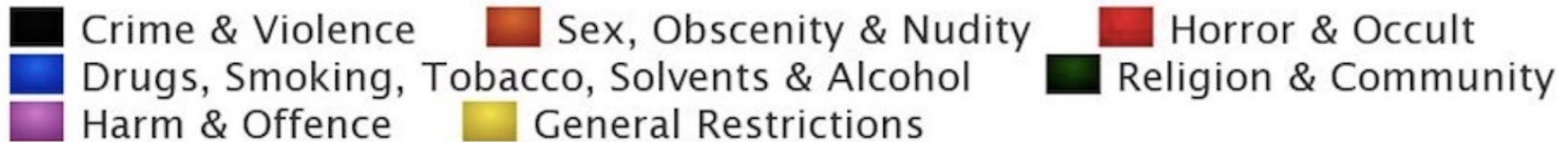
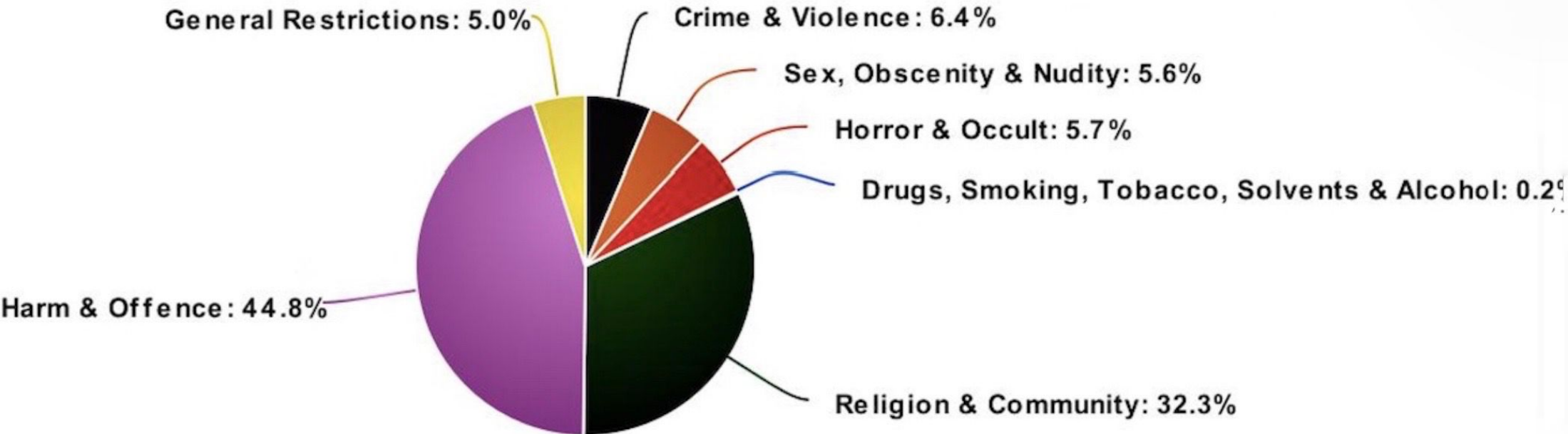
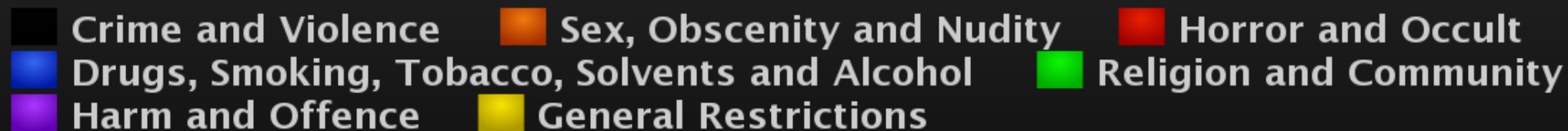
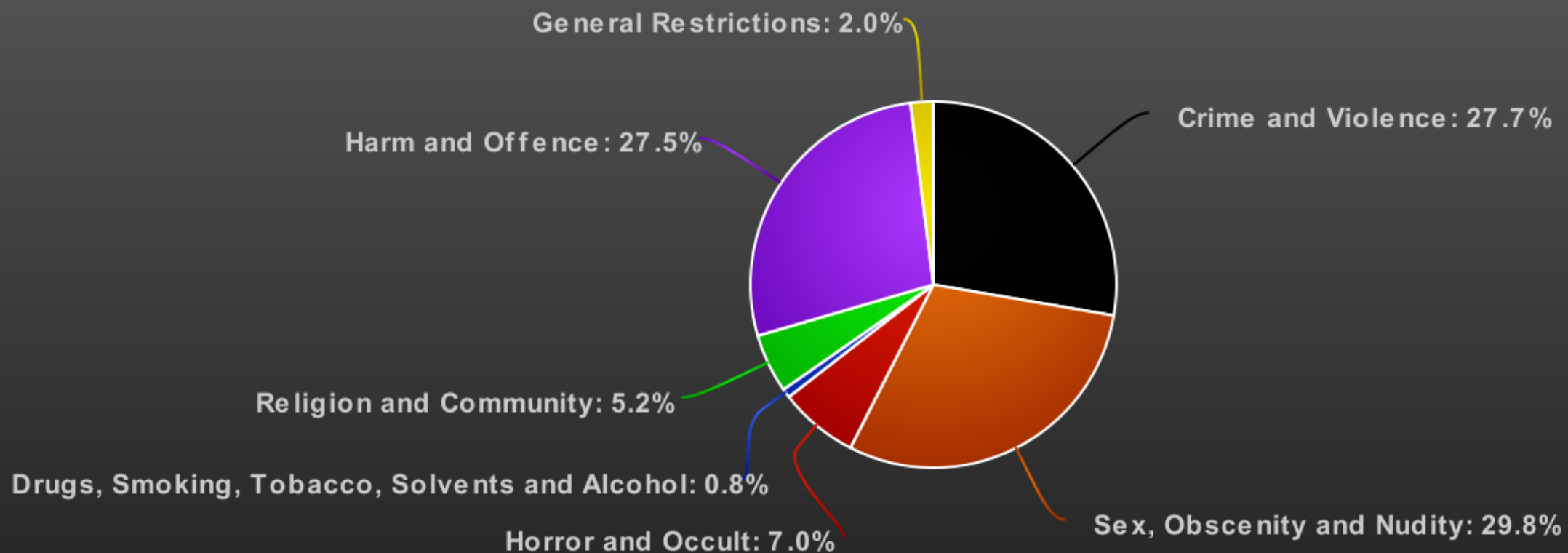


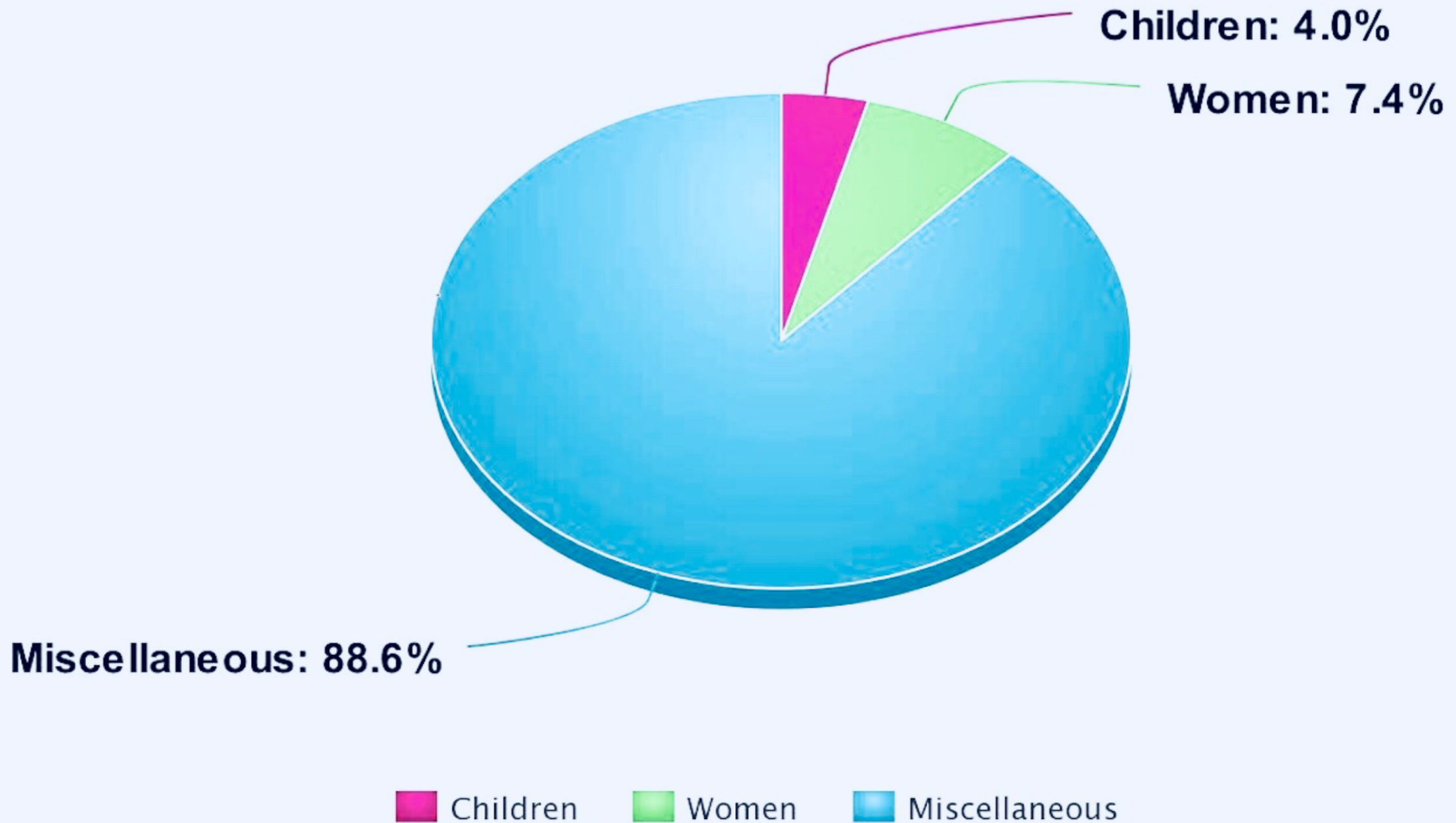
Valid Content Complaints (2018)



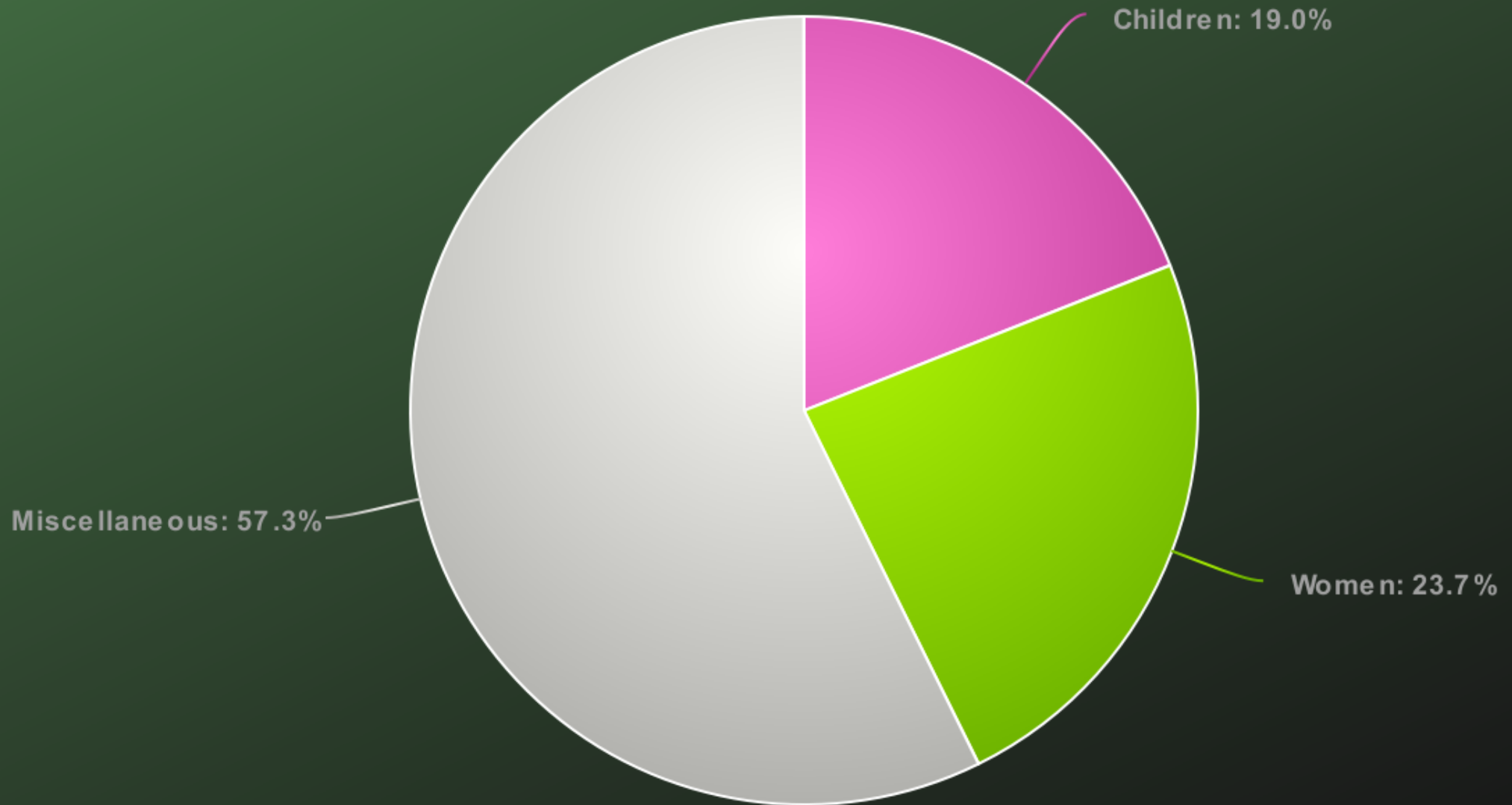

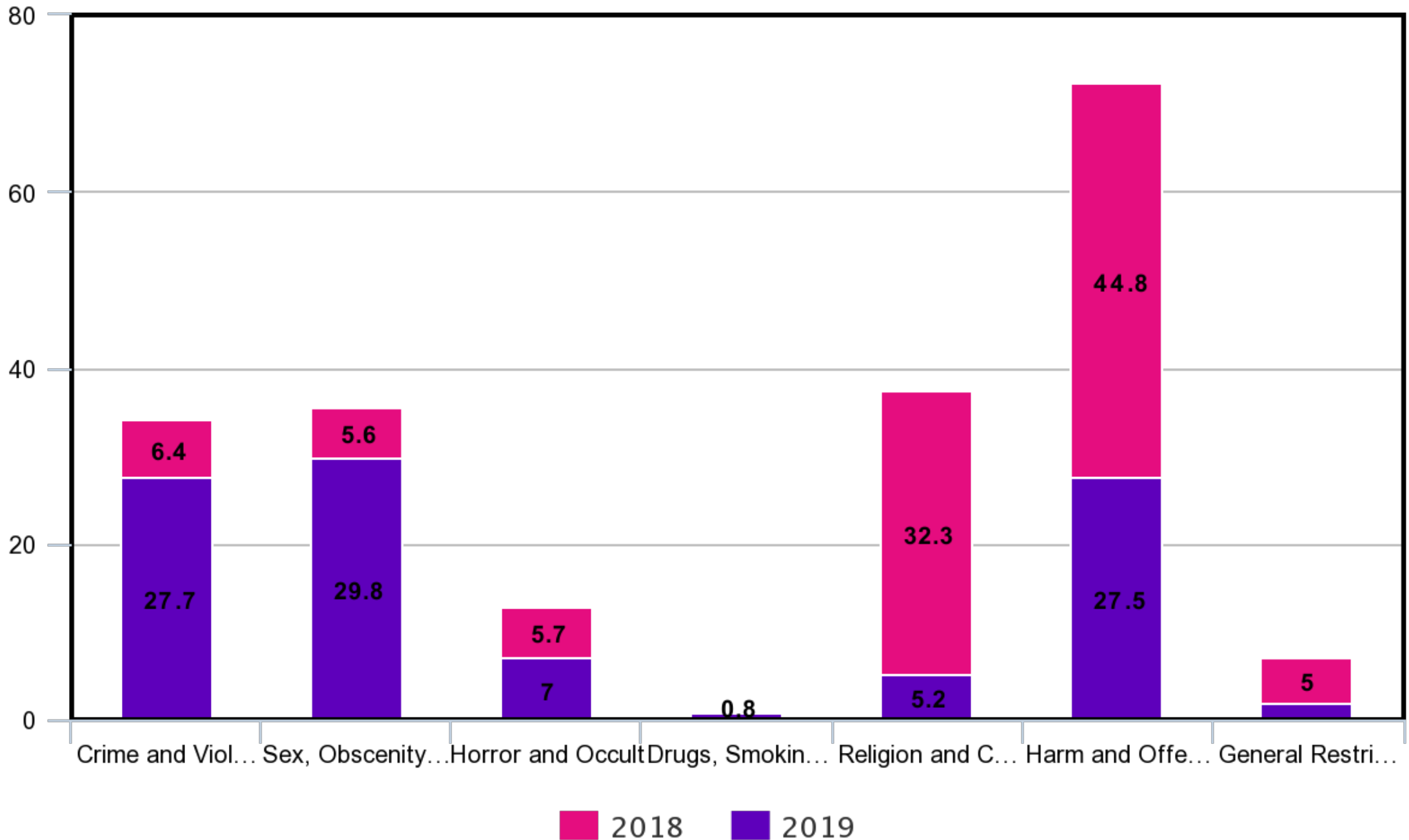

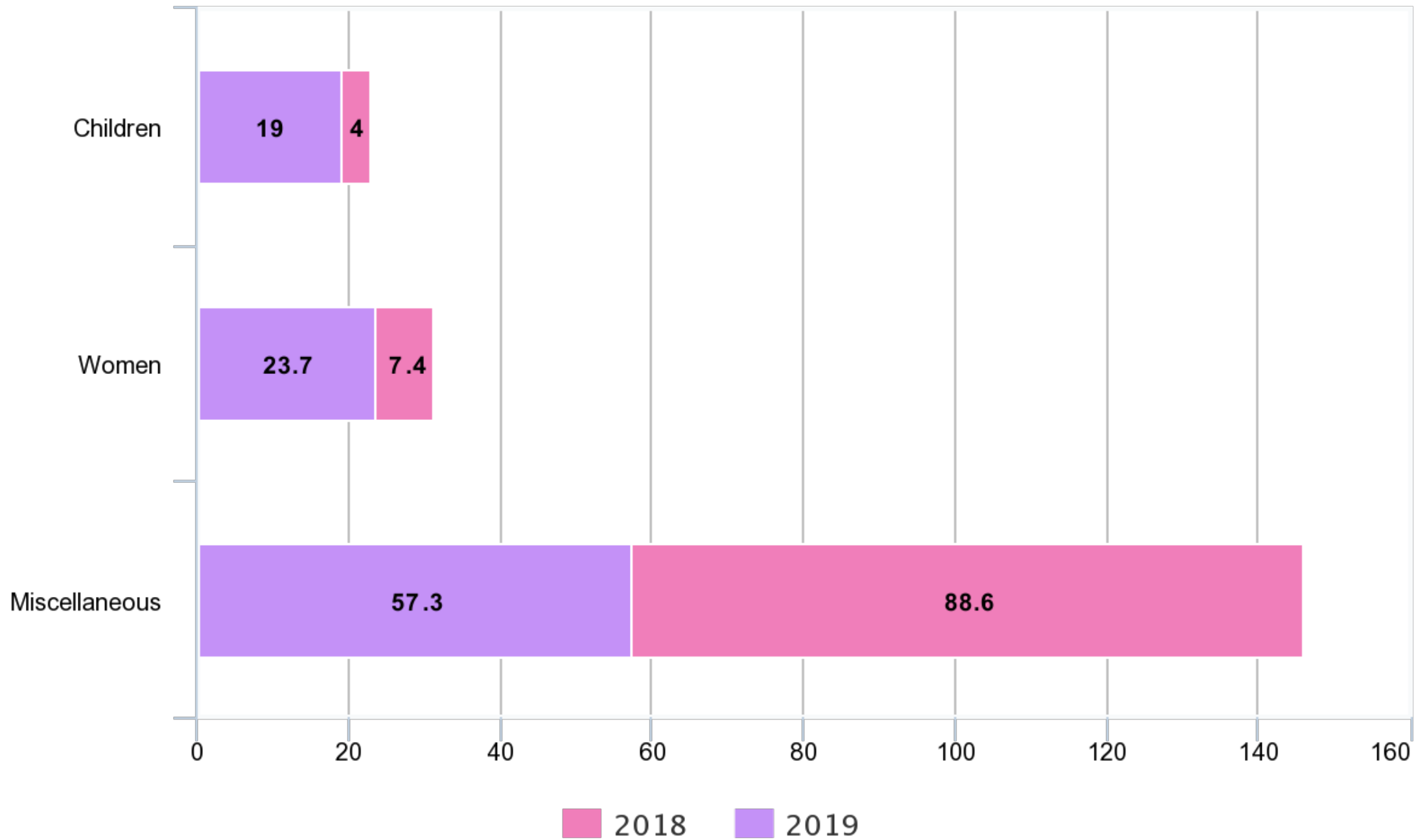

Valid Complaints pertaining to Women and Children 2018-19



- The themes of ‘Crime and Violence’ and ‘Sex, Obscenity and Nudity’ have both seen an over 20 point jump from the year 2018 to 2019, having risen from a 6.4% to a 27.7% and a 5.6% to a 29.8% respectively, of the valid complaints.
- The theme of ‘Harm and Offence’ fell from a 44.8% to a 27.5% of the overall valid complaints from 2018 to 2019.
- The theme of ‘Religion and Community’ saw a drastic fall, reducing to less than its half from 2018 to 2019.
- The valid complaints pertaining to women and children took a major jump, rising from 7.4% to 23.7% in the case of women and, from 4% to 19% in the case of children.
- A large chunk of the valid complaints pertaining to women were concerned with the depiction of abuse and torture being meted out to women while with regards to children, it was their involvement in circumstances inappropriate for them to be involved in that viewers found problematic.
- The overall number of valid complaints fell from 5,135 in 2018 to 1,598 in 2019.
